We are learning to...

We are learning to...

Look at signs of Autumn using all our senses to explore the natural world.

Spend time looking at photos and memories.

Physical Development

We are learning to...

Wash and dry our hands independently before snack and after the toilet.

Use large muscle movements to make marks.

Use one handed tools such as scissors to make snips in paper.
